Who does Round-Up for Riders benefit?

Round-Up for Riders directly impacts each of the individuals impacted by the mission of Wings of Hope Equitherapy just south of Fort Worth. Over 125 individuals with varying degrees of physical, mental and emotional challenges partner with our 22 equine therapy horses to participate in equine assisted activities every week at Wings of Hope. It is our belief that inclusion for people with disabilities and challenges in our community is a priority. People affected by a wide variety of challenges such as Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Down Syndrome, Multiple Sclerosis, PTSD and more are impacted by our mission.

What is Round-Up for Riders?

Round-Up for Riders is the annual dinner and auction benefiting the mission of Wings of Hope. Join us on Friday August 4, 2017 at 6:00 for an evening that includes dinner, "Boots-Up", and a variety of auctions. Last year, 300 generous donors helped us raise over \$147,000.

Why should I support Round-Up for Riders?

We are looking to community supporters and friends to contribute to the success of the event through in kind donations of items that can be sold during our silent auction. Round-Up for Riders can showcase your business through the Silent Auction, Raffle and Pick-A-Package areas.

Silent Auction: Every year our guest list of 300+ enjoy shopping for a cause while supporting local business'. A donation of your good or service in the form of an item or gift certificate is easily viewed by each of our 300+ guests. Your donation will be featured along with any business materials you provide. These materials are viewed by the auction winner in addition to being viewed by all guests during the event. *Silent Auction items have an average value of \$15-\$500.*

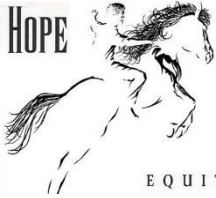
Raffle: Each year various high end items are exclusively featured in a Raffle format that highlights 10-12 packages consisting of items and/or experiences. The Raffle area at the event is set up in a concentrated area that is set apart from Silent Auction items. *Items featured in the raffle, on average have a value of \$250-\$2,000.*

Pick-A-Package: This auction area is a way for all donors to directly support a rider on scholarship at WOH! On average 75-100 Pick-A-Packages are sold during the event for \$30. Each package contains a gift certificate worth \$25 or more. Gift certificates for goods or services pertaining to Dining, Entertainment, or Shopping & Services are a great way to promote your business, gain a new customer and provide additional exposure to your business. This area is a high flow area and every business receives promotional signage during the event. Most gift card items donated to Round-Up for Riders are featured through the Pick-A-Package. *Gift cards of all denominations are welcome. Each Pick-A-Package contains a combined value of a minimum of \$25 and an average of \$30-\$250 per package.*

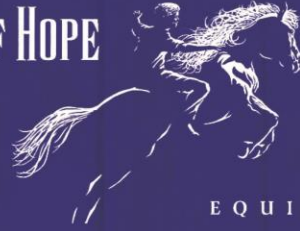
